**NOTE:** These are general time frames for disease occurrence. Depending on local weather and site conditions, disease outbreak and the duration of activity may vary. Remember the genetic susceptibility of the grass and the weather are the predominate factors driving the occurrence of disease development and severity.

All young/juvenile grasses are vulnerable to seedling diseases problems such as Pythium and Rhizoctonia.
